Is Christianity a religion?

Depends on your definition. Latin-'religo' to tie, bind, from to tie to God

If it is a set of beliefs and practices? Yes Has answers to ultimate questions? Yes Word is used in the Bible, often quite negatively lames I:26-27 Acts 17:22

If it is spiritual efforts to reach God, No. If it is about what we do? No

Uniqueness of Christianity

Most religions involve human efforts. They require good deeds to progress e.g. Karma. We earn our progress.

The Bible says we unable to reach God. John 3:3 Colossians 2:13 Grace, and a gift. Jesus did the work, not us. Ephesians 2:8-9

2 Timothy 2:12 Not 'what' but 'whom'

Jesus only founder who was God and rose again. John 8:58,

Only belief, where Founder dies for our sin.

Is Christianity the only way?

All other religions accept that access to Heaven etc is open to all people, only Christians exclusive. Why? Being sincere/good intentions enough? If you believe in absolute truth, and the religions say different things, some things said must be false. Truth is exclusive.

If we believed the Christian faith was just one good philosophy among many, then can accept other ways. However the core of our faith is Christ died for us.

Only one God Isaiah 45:21 Only one way - John 6:40, 8:24, 14:6, Acts 4:12, I Timothy 2:5

Isn't saying 'only one way' intolerant?

Tolerance is only a good virtue is some situations. A faith that says 'everyone goes to Heaven' would be seen as a 'good religion'. But if false, then it would be wrong to say it, just to please people. We are not claiming 'Christian teachings are the best,' but we are saying, our sin had to be paid for. If a doctor told you there was only one way to cure you, would anyone claim he was intolerant?

Can I be confident that Christianity is true?

- Power to change lives, including yours!

How do we avoid becoming a cult/religion?

- Focus on Christ, not leaders.
- Avoid use of proof texts.
- Live balanced lives, not obsessive.
- Avoid inward looking.
- Encourage people to think.
- Focus on bearing fruit. Matthew 7:15-20

How do we handle people of different beliefs?

- With love and respect.
- Share your personal faith John 9:25
- Ask thought provoking questions.
- Don't wage war over beliefs/doctrine.
- Don't allow them to deliver their patter.

Buddhism	People can one day reach 'Nirvana', a blissful spiritual existence. By following the 8 fold path people can build up good karma. The ultimate aim is to eliminate desire & become enlightened	Buddhism does not include God. The Buddha was not a god but a man who reached enlightenment The Eight Fold Path, includes Right Mindfulness, Right Speech etc 'The liberation of self is the responsibility of one's own self.'
Judaism	Everyone will go to heaven, although there are punishments and rewards. Keeping the law pleases G-d. Jews have special role in the World	The Torah contains the Key instructions for life. The laws affect every area of life e.g. Food -Kosher and Kashrut Judaism is a family faith, you are a Jew if your mother is one. People can convert to Judaism, but not easy.
Sikhism	Sikhs also believe in reincarnation and karma. We will go on being reborn until we are purified and can become 'one with God'. We need to become an absolute good human being.	The holy book, Guru Granth Sahib, is the 'living guru'. A committed Sikh wears the 5 K's, I. Kesh (uncut hair) 2. Kanga (comb) 3. Kara (bracelet) 4. Kirpan (sword) 5. Kachera (shorts) All religions lead to God– Guru Nanak 'There is no Hindu/Sikh'

Jehovah Witnesses	People need to believe in the sacrifice of Jesus, but good works like preaching should follow. Non Witnesses can be saved by serving God.	The top 144,000 witnesses will be in Heaven, the rest will live on Earth. A lot of emphasis on the 'kingdom of God' and end times. Non-Trinitarian.
Mormons Church of Jesus Christ of Later Day Saints	Through both faith and works. There are 3 levels of heaven, only Mormons go to celestial Heaven. Only a few (v bad) people go to Hell	There is the Bible and Book of Mormon, both inspired by God Joseph Smith taught Jesus went to America after ascension, and that he had to restore 'true' Christianity. Non Trinitarian
