Eschatology is the study of the 'last things'. Eschatos (Greek) = last

In once sense all time since Jesus, till the end of time is the 'last days'.

Are we near the end?

It can all be very confusing, so why bother?

- I. It mattered to Jesus.
- 2. We remember there is a plan to history.
- 3. We remember there is a purpose, reason for World history.
- 4. We remember that ultimately the Devil will be defeated, evil, suffering will end. Revelation 20 v10
- 5. We remember that our activity now, has a purpose and is part of big picture

However, not a topic to take us over, and to try and play guessing games with God's word.

God knows the dates! Matthew ch 24 v36

If I die tonight as a believer what will happen to me? Two ideas of this intermediate state

- 1. Soul sleep. Dead are aware of nothing, from when you die till end times seems like a split second
- 2. Conscious existence till end times. Luke 23 v43 Come with Jesus from Heaven to collect others at the end.

<u>Hell</u> Some have suggested 'annihilation' however difficult to support from scriptures. They quote 'destruction' Philippians 3 v19, I Thessalonians 5 v3 2 Peter 3 v7, How can you suffer if destroyed? Is annihilation punishment?


